

FROM FEBRUARY 2021 TO SEPTEMBER 2022, HE SERVED AS INTERIM DEAN OF THE RENAISSANCE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE. HE WAS VICE DEAN FOR ACADEMIC AFFAIRS AT THE RENAISSANCE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE AT STONY BROOK UNIVERSITY FROM SEPTEMBER 2022 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 2023. AND HE PREVIOUSLY WAS VICE DEAN FOR GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION FROM 2016-2021. HE HAS ALSO SERVED AS ASSOCIATE DEAN FOR CLINICAL OUTREACH, PRESIDENT OF THE MEDICAL STAFF OF STONY BROOK UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL. EXECUTIVE VICE CHAIR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MEDICINE. AND PROGRAM DIRECTOR OF THE INTERNAL MEDICINE RESIDENCY. A GRADUATE OF HARVARD COLLEGE AND NEW YORK UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE. DR. WERTHEIM TRAINED IN INTERNAL MEDICINE AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MICHIGAN HOSPITALS. WHERE HE DID HIS RESIDENCY AND CHIEF RESIDENCY. HE HAS A MASTERS IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION FROM BRANDEIS UNIVERSITY'S HELLER SCHOOL FOR SOCIAL POLICY AND MANAGEMENT.

SEAN MCSWEENEY, PHD

DR. SEAN MCSWEENEY HAS EARNED HIS BS IN CHEMISTRY AND PHYSICS WITH JOINT HONORS FIRST CLASS IN 1986 AND HIS PHD IN PHYSICAL CHEMISTRY IN 1991 FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MANCHESTER IN THE UNITED KINGDOM. MCSWEENEY HAS EXPERTISE IN STRUCTURAL BIOLOGY AT SYNCHROTRON FACILITIES. A MAJOR INNOVATION OF HIS WORK, AND THE PART OF THE TEAMS HE HAS LED, IS IN MAKING COMPLEX X-RAY TOOLS ACCESSIBLE IN A COST-EFFECTIVE FASHION. HE ALSO HAS EXPERTISE IN AUTOMATION OF CRYSTALLOGRAPHIC EXPERIMENTS WHICH INCLUDES: THE AUTOMATION OF MX EXPERIMENT REQUIRING THE AUTOMATION OF PHOTON DELIVERY AND PREPARATION. THE AUTOMATION OF SAMPLE HANDLING UNDER CRYOGENIC CONDITIONS, THE ALIGNMENT OF THE SAMPLE TO THE X-RAY BEAM, INITIAL DIFFRACTION ASSESSMENT AND PLANNING OF THE BEAMLINES, AND THE EVALUATION OF THE DATA BEING COLLECTED.
